

## **Quilters**

The Quilters were organized in 1981 to provide quilts for the social. We are a subcommittee of the Ladies' Club. However, you do not have to be a Ladies' Club member (or a parishioner) to quilt. Nor do you have to quilt to be a Ladies Club member. Our mission is to provide fellowship for the quilters and quilts for the social and the Men's Club auction. We make 11 quilts each year for the social and 1 for the auction. We are a self supporting group. The 12 quilts we make are donated to St. Matthew Parish and all proceeds go to the parish. After we finish the church quilts, we quilt for people in the community. The money we make from this quilting pays for our supplies and an occasional pizza. We meet each Wednesday during the school year in the old rectory. The quilts are put together by volunteers in their homes. Some ladies quilt for an hour and some from 8:00 to 3:00. Since 1981, we have donated over 330 quilts to St. Matthew Parish and have earned the parish over \$138,000. We welcome new quilters. If you can sew, you can probably quilt.
